

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF
THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD
OCTOBER 1, 2007**

I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Anderson called the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Springfield to order at 7:30 p.m.

II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Anderson led the pledge of allegiance.

III. ROLL CALL

Present: Council Members Agne, Burdett, Eib, Good, Hinton, Whitfield, and Mayor Anderson.

Also Present: Franklin Peterson – City Manager, and Kris Vogel – City Clerk.

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

It was moved by Hinton, seconded by Good and unanimous that the minutes of September 17, 2007, regular meeting be approved subject to additions and corrections.

V. REPORTS

A. City Manager – *Franklin Peterson*

1. Adopt – Revised Fee Schedule

City Manager Peterson stated the following resolution would adopt the revised fee schedule; changes include fees for police reports and craft show vendor fees for electricity.

It was moved by Eib and seconded by Good and Whitfield that the following resolution be adopted:

City Clerk Vogel informed the public that the Calhoun County Road Commission is conducting their annual tire and appliance collection the week of October 1st; for specific information on this event, please call City Clerk Vogel at City Hall.

City Manager Peterson stated he had his third Coffee With the City Manager this morning and thanked Art Hollingsworth for coming in and chatting with him; Coffee With the City Manager is held the first Monday of each month from 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.

City Manager Peterson stated our new Assessor, Dan Brunner, started today and will be in the office every Monday and Friday.

Mayor Anderson asked if Dan Brunner and James Conner could attend the next meeting to meet the Council. City Manager Peterson indicated he would make these arrangements.

Mayor Anderson stated last fall City Manager Jenkins and herself attended a reading of Charlotte's Web at Endeavor Charter Academy, where the group participated for the record for "Most People Reading Aloud Simultaneously in Multiple Locations". The school broke the record and are having a celebration on Friday, October 5th; anyone who wishes to attend should contact City Clerk Vogel or Charter Endeavor Academy to RSVP.
